

Humanities Major Course Requirements



Foundation Courses – 100 credits required

- English (Honors / AP optional) – 40 credits
- Social Science (AP optional) – 30 credits
- Spanish 1-3 OR French 1–3 – 30 credits
- **OR** Spanish 1-2 AND French 1-2 – 40 credits

Breadth Courses – 30 credits required

- Spanish 4 / AP OR French 4 – 10 credits
- Humanities Café – 5 credits
- Creative Writing - 5 credits
- History of Rock - 5 credits
- Film and Fiction - 5 credits

Capstone Course – 10 credits required

- Senior Project / Portfolio - 10 credits

Other Electives – 20 credits required

- Performing Arts Foundation, Vocal or Instrumental Music, Dance, Theatre, Musical Theatre, Art, Journalism, or Advanced Journalism
